BARRATT LONDON GO GARDENING WITH VOLUNTEERING DAY AT HENDON ALLOTMENTS

On Monday 8th August, staff from housebuilder Barratt London, responsible for the Hendon Waterside development on Moorhen Drive, spent the day volunteering for West Hendon Allotment Society (WHAS). The team of nine volunteers swapped their steel-toed boots for gardening gloves to help clear the allotments car park of debris and overgrown plants.

Under the supervision of representatives from WHAS, the team of sales advisors and site managers were able to clear a significant proportion of the overgrown plants and stubborn foliage at the entrance to the site. As a result of their hard work, the allotment plot-holders will now have access to over five additional spaces in the car park.

Justin Bissell, Chairman of West Hendon Allotment Society, comments: "On behalf of all our members and plot-holders, I would like to thank Barratt London for their hard work at the site. The car park at the entrance to our allotments has been overgrown and difficult to use for a long time now, and we have always planned to clear it but never had the time. At weekends, the allotments can get very busy and it's great to know that we are no longer limited by the number of people who can park on site."

As part of the housebuilder's commitment to the local communities surrounding its developments, staff from Barratt London regularly partake in volunteering opportunities. In Hendon, workers at the site have previously spent a day litter picking on the nearby Welsh Harp Reservoir, making the area a cleaner space for residents and visitors to enjoy.

DID YOU KNOW?

Not all the integrated bat and bird bricks installed at Hendon Waterside are the same and we don't just mean the different colours. We install many specifically designed bricks to help encourage roosting bats and nesting birds such as Swifts, House Sparrows and Black Redstarts.

If you look closely around the development, you may notice a number of these bricks and if you are lucky, see one of your new neighbours.

MTVH PROPERTY AND HOUSING SERVICES

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Works at West Hendon continue to move at a good pace, and we are getting ready for our first handovers in the newly constructed tower. Scaffolding is on its way down and is slowly showing off all our hard work that has been undertaken over the last year.

Work at West Hendon is highly consistent and the site team have been nominated for several awards this year. The site team prides itself on working at a good pace, whilst also maintaining high standards in their work.

West Hendon was also nominated for the Barratt London safety award with the results yet to be announced.

Major Highways Works - West Hendon Broadway

We would like to update you regarding the upcoming highway works due to be carried out within the West Hendon Broadway area. You may already be aware of these plans via recent letters posted to individual residents & business owners. In case you have not been notified, we hope that this article will reassure you of the positive long-term impact the works will have within the local community and provide an update as to the new timings of these works.

The improvements which are being made to the highways and public realm are part of Phase 4 of the wider regeneration of West Hendon, and will include:

• Pedestrian improvements to Perryfield Way, with the closure of one lane to slow traffic and allow safe crossing from Damsel Walk to Hendon Waterside and the Welsh Harp, as requested by community representatives on the West Hendon Partnership Board.

This work is due to commence later this month and will take approximately 4 weeks to complete.

It is anticipated that highway works along The Broadway will start early in the new year of 2023, subject to receiving the requisite permits. The works will take around 12 months to complete and will include:

- Improvements to the highway and pavements along the Broadway
- · Widening of Station Road, with improved pedestrian area and increasing to two-way traffic, improving access to the Hendon Station
- Removal of the Perryfield Way gyratory
- Removal of Herbert Road gyratory traffic
- Improvements to the Cool Oak Lane and A5 junction
- New and improved pedestrian crossings and public realm

These necessary changes will not only improve the high street and its accessibility but will also significantly improve the quality of vehicle and pedestrian access and movement. We will ensure local businesses and residents are regularly updated regarding progress.

A leaflet is due to be delivered later this year with further information on what you can expect, and a drop-in Q&A session will also be taking place in due course. Businesses will be visited by the Project Team closer to the start of the works.
